INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARING BIOINTERPHASES MANUSCRIPTS

Papers presented at the E-MRS Workshop on Organic Bioelectronics are encouraged to be submitted for publication in the November/December 2017 issue of <u>Biointerphases</u>. The papers will be peer reviewed.

Papers will be reviewed according to criteria set by Biointer*phases* and must meet Biointer*phases* standards for both technical content and written English. All manuscripts are reviewed to the same standards as regular Biointer*phases* submissions.

In preparing your article, you should follow the instructions for contributors, which may be found on the Information for Contributors link at

Authors are encouraged to use the Biointer*phases* templates. The easiest way to prepare your manuscript is to use the available Biointer*phases* Article Template to delete and replace text as necessary. *Click here for the Biointerphases Template for MS Word.* This file and the template used to create it are attached/available through your conference site/chair and at the site above.

Note that acceptance to present at the conference does not guarantee the acceptance of the manuscript. To be published in Biointer*phases*, the manuscript must:

(1) present original findings, conclusions or analysis that have not been published previously by the authors or others,

- (2) be free of errors and ambiguities,
- (3) support conclusions with data and analysis,
- (4) be written clearly, and
- (5) have high impact in its field, which must be within the scope of topics covered by the journal.

Note: Authors should select "Article", "Review", or "Perspective" as the type of paper within the conference In Focus issue choice.

It is VERY IMPORTANT that authors indicate to which conference/special issue the paper is submitted.

Acceptable manuscript file types are MSWord, LaTeX, and PDF. For the initial submission/review process, a single PDF or MSWord file including the figures is sufficient. However, once a paper is accepted, MSWord or TeX file of the text, any tables and the list of figure captions along with the separate figure files will be required for final production. Use of color in Figures is free and encouraged.

Prepare illustrations in the final published size, not oversized or undersized.
