Frequently Asked Questions (Q&A)

Q: Who are the organizers?

A: The event is organized by the CEOPS project, a consortium of 10 partners. Prof. Jacques Amouroux (ENSCP/UPMC/EMRS) organized the scientific content of the school, with the help of Prof. Joan Ramon Morante (IREC), Xianhong Wang (Changchun Institute of Applied Chemistry, CAS) and Zinfer Ismagilov (Boreskov Institute of Catalysis, RAS). Q: Where is the event held?

A: The event will take place at the Lille Grand Palais, 1 Boulevard des Cités Unies, 59800 Lille, France.

Q: What is the target audience?

A: The school programme is suitable for Master, PhD and Post Doc-level students as well as engineers.

Q: How can I attend?

A: Please note that a registration to the event is necessary. Please register online under www.ceops-project.eu before 30th April 2015.

Q: What are the registration requirements?

A: Your registration to the school implies that:

- You have an advanced level of English a documented study/research/work experience in the field
- You have the possibility to assist all day of the School
- You will bring a poster



Q: How will the poster session be organized?

A: In a pedagogical approach, time slots will be dedicated for exchange and discussion around posters of the students. You are asked to bring your printed poster (The viewable size of the poster board is: vertical 1.10 m and horizontal 0.90 m) and be present at your poster for discussion with participants. It is your responsibility to remove the poster at the end of the event.

Q: Is the event free of charge?

A: Admission to the school, lunch, breaks and a dinner are provided to all registered participants. Travel (fixed price) and 1 night accommodation are covered for students who ask for a financial support (see procedure below).

Q: How do I apply for financial support and how does it work?

As a student (Master, PhD or PostDoc), you can apply for financial support by checking the box “I am applying for financial support” when filling your Application Form online.

The CEOPS project will support all meals during the School day and **reimburse** you:

- 1 night accommodation
- Travel (fixed price to max. 200 €)

Reimbursement procedure:

- Your bank account information (IBAN, BIC, Name of the Bank, Name of account holder)
- The original (keep a copy) boarding pass & invoice.
