The 2019 E-MRS Exhibition will provide a unique opportunity to present innovative products and services of interest to the materials community.



2. ARRANGEMENT OF EXHIBITS

E-MRS reserves the right to determine final placement of the Exhibitor. Exhibitors agree to arrange their exhibits so as not to obstruct the general view of nor hide other exhibits. The booth decoration must be realized with non-inflammable or fireproofing materials. Exhibitors must use extreme caution when operating equipment which could cause eye damage, emit excessive radiation or in any way harm visitors in the exhibit area.

3. INSTALLATION

One half day for setting-up the booth, **Monday May 27 from 14:00 to 19:00**. Pick packages up to the Exhibition Hall. The storage of the empty boxes has to be planned with the Convention Centre.


It is forbidden to use nails, screws or glue on the structure. Any deterioration caused by the installations and decorations of any kind will be borne by the exhibitors.


12. CANCELLATION


Espace Agora – level 2 (already booked)



BY ROAD

Nice is connected to all the great European cities by a major motorway network. In particular, the A8 motorway, 'La Provençale', running from Aix-en-Provence to the West to the Italian border on the East.
