



Founded in 1983, the European Materials Research Society (E-MRS) now has more than 4,000 members from industry, government, academia and research laboratories, who meet regularly to debate on recent technological developments of functional materials. The E-MRS differs from many single-discipline professional societies by encouraging scientists, engineers and research managers to exchange information on an interdisciplinary platform, and by recognizing professional and technical excellence by promoting awards for achievement from student to senior scientist level.

As an adhering body of the International Union of Materials Research Societies (IUMRS), the E-MRS enjoys and benefits from very close relationships with other Materials Research organizations elsewhere in Europe and around the world.

Each year, E-MRS organizes, co-organizes, sponsors or co-sponsors numerous scientific events and meetings. The major society conference, the E-MRS Spring Meeting, is organized every year in May or June, and offers on average 25 topical symposia. It is widely recognized as being of the highest international significance and is the greatest of its kind in Europe with about 2,500 attendees every year.

Each symposium publishes its own proceedings that document the latest experimental and theoretical understanding of material growth and properties, the exploitation of new advanced processes, and the development of electronic devices that can benefit best from the outstanding physical properties of functional materials.




TOP 10 AT SPRING MEETING 2023 - GEOGRAPHICAL ANALYSIS

The E-MRS Spring Meeting draws an audience from 56 different countries. Representing quality and quantity, this audience comprises key decision-makers involved in the field of materials research.






2. ARRANGEMENT OF EXHIBITS

E-MRS reserves the right to determine final placement of the Exhibitor. Exhibitors agree to arrange their exhibits so as not to obstruct the general view of nor hide other exhibits. The booth decoration must be realized with non-inflammable or fireproofing materials. Exhibitors must use extreme caution when operating equipment which could cause eye damage, emit excessive radiation or in any way harm visitors in the exhibit area.

3. INSTALLATION


One half day for setting-up the booth, **Monday May 27 from 13:30 to 18:30**. Pick packages up to the Exhibition Hall. The arrangement of the booths has to be imperatively finished at this time, due to the constraints of the regular control done by the Safety Department of the Convention Center. The storage of the empty boxes has to be planned with the Convention Center.

It is forbidden to use nails, screws or glue on the structure. Any deterioration caused by the installations and decorations of any kind will be borne by the exhibitors. The walls of the exhibition halls, pillars, stairs, doors and others shall not be used for purposes of decoration. In addition to this, it is forbidden to: tamper with the waste heat, flues, waterpipes, compressed air ducts, electrical and phone circuits, water or drain network.

Car parking nearby: 850 spaces - PEX - rue Fritz-Kieffer (next to Hotel Hilton). It is strictly forbidden to park in the technical courtyard at the PALAIS DES CONGRÈS, except when unloading.

4. DISMANTLING THE BOOTH

On **Thursday May 30, starting at 16:30 AFTER THE COFFEE BREAK (mandatory)**. Exhibitors are bound to dismantle their booth and deliver it in its initial state. Eventual repair costs will be invoiced to the exhibiting company.

International Delivery

International packages must be shipped with International Commercial Terms in DDP (Delivered Duty Paid). Goods delivered to final destination, import customs clearance and taxes payable by the seller / shipper.

Storage of packaging

STRASBOURG EVENTS does not have premises for the storage of empty packaging during the duration of exhibitions. These must therefore be immediately removed as and when assembly and, if necessary, brought back at the time of disassembly.

All packaging type storage: cartons, cans, pallets, in the exhibition surfaces, in the clearances as well as in the immediate surroundings of the halls is strictly forbidden.

Unloading trucks and transport to the stand

7. PICKUP

The removal must be done on the day of disassembly on Thu. May 30 after 16:30 or preferably Fri. May 31 between 8:00 and 11:30 am.

The PALAIS DES CONGRES cannot contact your carrier on your behalf. You must ensure the repackaging of your equipment, labeling, and leave the packages on your stand. The responsibility of STRASBOURG EVENTS cannot be engaged in any way on the disappearance or destruction of any material left after the event.

You must also check that your package is billed and paid to your carrier before making your request for recovery of your package, whether for its transport but also regarding customs clearance if necessary. The Palais des Congrès reserves the right to refuse delivery if the information necessary for its return is not indicated. 





REACHING STRASBOURG

Strasbourg enjoys excellent national and international connections, with a TGV high-speed train station with direct access to trains in the city center.

by air:

Strasbourg-Entzheim International Airport - Strasbourg airport is just 9 minutes from the city center by train. It offers several flights a day to and from Paris Orly as well as some international connections, for example Amsterdam, Bruxelles, Londres Gatwick, Lyon, Madrid, Nice, Prague, Rome. Paris Charles de Gaulle (France) – Directly from the airport, you can take a TGV to Strasbourg. When booking with Air France, your airfare can include the transportation by TGV to the Strasbourg main station. More information on http://www.parisaeroport.fr/en

Basel-Mulhouse-Freiburg Airport (France)- one-hour twenty minutes by train (take the shuttle bus to the Saint-Louis train station (Line 11) and then catch the train to Strasbourg). More information on http://www.euroairport.com/en/

Karlsruhe/Baden-Baden Airport (Germany) is located about 60km away in Germany. The best way to get to Strasbourg is to get a bus from the airport to Baden-Baden Hauptbahnhof (Main Station) from here trains run to Strasbourg, normally with one change. Frankfurt International Airport (Germany) is about 2h30 hours away from Strasbourg, and is one of the nearest inter-continental airports to Strasbourg, with Paris Charles de Gaulle. 

Strasbourg has one of the largest railway stations in France and enjoys direct TGV connections to many French towns and cities. by road:

Strasbourg can be reached from various directions:

- From the west (Paris, Benelux) taking the A4 highway (E25). About 4 hours from Paris;
- From the south (Switzerland, Lyon), taking the A35 highway (E25). About 5 hours from Lyon;
- From the north and east (Germany), taking the A5 highway (E35).

The Strasbourg-Mulhouse route joins it to the rest of the French motorway network. Strasbourg is fifteen minutes from the Hamburg-Frankfurt-Basel-Genova or Milan motorway, itself linked to the entire European motorway network.

by bus:

Strasbourg can be reached by bus at attractive prices from major European cities. Four agencies, Eurolines, Isilines, Flixbus et Ouibus provide bus connections with Strasbourg and cities like Amsterdam, Barcelona, Basel, Brussels, Bucharest, Budapest, Frankfurt, Krakow, London, Lyon, Marseille, Munich, Vienna, Zurich, ...
